Members of the Executive Committee Call for Nominations

Positions available for nominations

Nominations are called for the following positions on the Executive Committee of Association of Quality Child Care Centres of NSW Inc (the Association), in accordance with Clauses 18.1 and 22.1(a) of the Association's Constitution:

- President
- Vice President
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- plus not more than 7 and not less than 3 members of the Executive Committee

Who can be nominated

Clause 22.1(c) of the Constitution requires that to be eligible to be a member of the Executive Committee a person must:

- 1. be an ordinary member or the representative of an ordinary member
- 2. have been continuously that member or that representative of that member for a minimum of 24 months (which timing would be from the date they would become a member of the Executive Committee which is the date of the AGM)
- 3. meet the nomination requirements in clause 29.6 of the Constitution which requires they be eligible to manage an incorporated body.

Clause 5.13 gives all the rights of an ordinary member to a life member, provided the life member is eligible to be an ordinary member. Hence, such life members are also eligible for nomination.

Clause 10.6 of the constitution requires that, to stand for election, the member must be financial, which means financial at the time of nomination.

Clause 2.2 of the constitution defines a 'financial member' as a member who has paid all monies due to the Association.

Nominations shall be made by 2 financial members of the Association on the attached Nomination Form. The form must also be signed by the Nominee accepting the nomination.

Clause 22.2 of the Constitution allows retiring members of the Executive Committee to be reelected.

Clause 29.6 allows an eligible member to be nominated for more than 1 position on the Executive Committee. Separate nomination forms should be submitted for each position.



Nomination process

Clause 29.6 of the Constitution specifies the nomination process as requiring the nomination:

- 1. be made in writing (which includes electronically submitted forms)
- 2. be signed by 2 financial members of the Association
- 3. include the written consent of the candidate of stand for election
- 4. be in the form which is in the appendix to the Constitution (and is attached to this call for nominations)
- 5. be delivered to the Returning Officer.

Timing

To be eligible nominations must be received by 5.00 pm, Friday, 3 October 2025.

Supporting Statement

Clause 29.(a)(iii) of the Constitution allows a candidate to submit a statement in support of their nomination. Such statements must not exceed 250 words and can be submitted separately to the nomination. Such statements will be accessible to members who are voting.

Defective nominations

Clause 29.7 of the Constitution requires that if the Returning Officer finds a nomination to be defective then, before rejecting the nomination, the Returning Officer provides the nominee with an opportunity to remedy the defect. Any such remedy must be received prior to the close of nominations.

Need for a ballot

Clause 29.10 requires that if more than the required number of nomination is received for a vacant position then a ballot will be required for the position.
